

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by R.C. Flemal):

On August 11, 1997, the complainant and respondent, Old World Industries, Inc., filed an agreed motion to extend the stay of proceedings in this matter. The parties request that the Board stay all proceedings in this matter for an additional 60 days to allow them to further engage in settlement negotiations.
