The program is to be completed by the end of 1972, and annual reapproval is required by the statute. The Agency tells us Marguette is making satisfactory progress in implementing the program, and no suggestion is made that the program is in need of modification. We therefore hereby grant an extension of the variance granted Jan 6, 1971 (# 70-23) for an additional year to permit orderly completion of the original program, as was contemplated by our earlier order. Conditions of the initial order, to the extent not mooted will remain in effect.
