ORDER OF THE BOARD BY (J. Anderson):

This matter comes before the Board on its own motion and with regards to the transfer of the petitioner's delisting files from the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) to the Board. In a prior Order of September 13, 1990 the Board directed the petitioner a) to indicate whether or not it wishes to proceed in the site-specific rulemaking procedure mode, b) to indicate whether or not the record received is complete and c) to supplement the record if desired.
