## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.E. Johnson):

On April 28, 2003, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which J & C Central, Inc. (J & C Central) may appeal an April 4, 2003 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.402, 105.406. At issue is the Agency's approval of the payment of corrective action costs, with deductions, for J & C Central's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at 586 Crescent Boulevard, Glen Ellyn, DuPage County. The Board extends the appeal period until August 7, 2003, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If J & C Central fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
