Recently I received training in understanding NPDES permits, and am aware how difficult they are for lay people to understand. The Clean Water Act envisioned strong public participation in the permitting process, and I believe that it is extremely important that every effort be made to simplify it, open it up, and provide for citizen input at every level. I am pleased to learn that the Illinois Pollution Control Board is considering the adoption of regulatory changes to strengthen public participation in the permitting process, and would urge the Board to adopt these changes.
