On March 20, 2003, at the parties' request, the Board extended until June 11, 2003, the time period for Pete's Marathon to appeal a February 6, 2003 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill.
