### MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE INSTANTER THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant the Illinois EPA leave to file instanter the Administrative Record for this matter. In support of this motion, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

- 1. The Petitioner, DaLee Oil Company, filed its appeal on or about May 8, 2003. The Illinois EPA received notice of the Petitioner's filing on May 9, 2003. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, the Administrative Record ("record") is to be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the filing of the petition. Accordingly, the record was due to be filed on or before June 7, 2003. That date was a Saturday, and the following business day was June 9, 2003.
- 2. This appeal is linked to a number of other appeals involving a common environmental consultant retained by the respective owners or operators that have filed petitions.
- 3. The Petitioner and the Illinois EPA have been in discussions regarding the resolution of this and all other related actions. Further, the parties have been in contact with the Hearing Officer assigned by the Board.
- 4. Following extensive discussions between the parties, the progress of which has been consistently and periodically provided to the Hearing Officer, the parties have agreed that a

number of other related appeals can be considered as either settled or not in need of a hearing at this time. Specifically, of 10 appeals involving the common consultant originally set for hearing in July, six have since been either resolved or will be stayed pending further efforts to resolve the underlying issues.

5. The time spent negotiating the resolution of these appeals has delayed submission of the Administrative Record, although the end results were certainly worth the effort expended. The Illinois EPA nonetheless regrets the delay, and hopes that the Board will accept this late filing.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Illinois EPA hereby respectfully requests that the Board grant the Illinois EPA leave to file instanter the Administrative Record.

Dear Mr. Kruep:

The Agency has completed the review of the request for reimbursement of corrective action costs from the Illinois Underground Storage Tank Fund for the above-referenced facility. The invoices reviewed covered the period from September 1, 2001 to November 30, 2001. The amount requested was \$14,788.85.

The deductible amount for this claim is \$15,000.00, which was previously deducted from the Invoice Voucher dated January 3, 1997. Listed in Attachment A are the costs which are not being reimbursed from this request and the reasons these costs are not being reimbursed.

On January 16, 2002, the Agency received your complete request for payment for this claim. As a result of the Agency's review of this claim, a voucher for \$12,193.03 will be prepared for submission to the Comptroller's Office for payment as funds become available based upon the date the Agency received your complete request for payment of this claim. Subsequent claims that have been/are submitted will be processed based upon the date complete subsequent billings requests are received by the Agency.

This constitutes the Agency's final action with regard to the above invoices. An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) pursuant to Section 22.18b(g) and Section 40 of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. The Agency has completed the review of the request for reimbursement of corrective action costs from the Illinois Underground Storage Tank Fund for the above-referenced facility. The invoices reviewed covered the period from April 1, 1995 to May 31, 1995. The amount requested was \$1,108.13.

• The deductible amount for this claim is \$15,000.00. On April 24, 1995, the Agency sent DaLee Oil Company a letter stating that the first request for reimbursement has been reviewed and the deductible was being deducted from that request.

On July 10, 1995, the Agency received your complete request for payment for this claim. The Reimbursement Eligibility and Deductible Application, received on 10-17-94 for the above referenced occurrence has been reviewed. The following determinations have been made based upon this review.

It has been determined that you are eligible to seek payment of costs in excess of \$15,000. The costs must be in response to the occurrence referenced above and associated with the following tanks:

You must contact the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to receive a packet of Agency billing forms for submitting your request for payment.

An owner or operator is eligible to access the Underground Storage Tank Fund if the eligibility requirements are satisfied:

- Neither the owner nor the operator is the United States Government; 1.
- 2. The tank does not contain fuel which is exempt from the Motor Fuel Tax Law;

3. The costs were incurred as a result of a confirmed release of any of the following substances:

"Fuel", as defined in Section 1.10 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law

Aviation fuel

Heating oil

Kerosene

Used oil, which has been refined from crude oil used in a motor vehicle, as defined in Section 1.3 of the Motor Fuel Tax Law.

- 4. The owner or operator registered the tank and paid all fees in accordance with the statutory and regulatory requirements of the Gasoline Storage Act.
- 5. The owner or operator notified the Illinois Emergency Management Agency of a confirmed release, the costs were incurred after the notification and the costs were a result of a release of a substance listed in this Section. Costs of corrective action or indemnification incurred before providing that notification shall not be eligible for payment.
- 6. The costs have not already been paid to the owner or operator under a private insurance policy, other written agreement, or court order.
- 7. The costs were associated with "corrective action".

This constitutes the final decision as it relates to your eligibility and deductibility. We reserve the right to change the deductible determination should additional information that would change the determination become available. An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal the decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board), pursuant to Section 57.9 (c) (2). An owner or operator who seeks to appeal the decision shall file a petition for a hearing before the Board within 35 days of the date of mailing of the final decision (35 Illinois Administrative Code 105.102(a) (2)).
