On July 10, 2003, at the parties' request, the Board extended until September 17, 2003, the time period for Tom's Gas Stop (Tom's Gas) to appeal a May 15, 2003 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill.
