
**DECISION DEADLINE WAIVER**

NOW COMES Petitioner, HOMEWOOD DISPOSAL SERVICE CO., by and through its attorneys, Sorling, Northrup, Hanna, Cullen & Cochran, Ltd., Charles J. Northrup, of counsel, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.105 waives the Pollution Control Board's ("Board") deadline for final action in this matter until June 30, 2004. In support Petitioner states:


