DEADLINE REGARDING
INSTALLATION OF
INTERLOCK DEVICES

COMES NOW, Respondent, T.L. Trucking Foodliner, and in support of their Application, states as follows:


1. The Illinois Pollution Control Board ordered numerous remedies be completed by Respondent in its Order dated August 7, 2003.
2. All items to be completed within 40 days of the ruling have been completed.
3. Items b, c and d, which were to be completed within 90 days of the ruling, have been completed.
4. Item a, namely installation of an interlock device, has not yet been completed.
5. Respondent has hired an expert to complete the interlock device.
6. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a letter from Applied Mechanical Technology, LLC, indicating that due to back order of some of the parts and the necessity of testing before installation, these interlock doors cannot be completed until approximately December 12, 2003.
7. Given that all other matters set out by the Board were met in a timely fashion, and delay in completion of this item is due to factors outside Respondent's control, Respondent respectfully requests that they be allowed until December 12, 2003, to finish the interlock overhead door system.

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests that the Board enter an Order allowing extension of the deadline to its required ruling under paragraph 4(a), namely, installation of interlock doors, until December 12, 2003.


Re: Scheduling for Electrical Interlocking

We have reviewed our scheduling, and checked inventory with our vendors on the supplies needed to manufacture the new electrical control panels for interlocking the tank cleaning equipment with the overhead doors. Some of the parts are back ordered and will not be at our facility until the week of November 17th. We will then need 5 - 6 days to build and test the panels. With the above availability we will start on-site installation either the last week of November or the first week of December with completion being 10 - 12 days after start date. I estimate that on or by 12/12/03 the new control panels will be installed & tested.
