

3. Ameren has no objection to postponing the date of the hearing. Ameren will suffer no material prejudice if the hearing is cancelled and rescheduled for a later date.



state:


1. I am a licensed attorney in the State of Illinois and am an Assistant Attorney General in the Illinois Attorney General's Office.

5. The Illinois Attorney General's Office has not previously filed a Motion to Cancel Hearing in this matter.

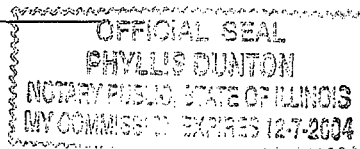


