**NOTICE OF PETITION BY CROWNLINE
BOATS, INC. FOR AN ADJUSTED STANDARD
BEFORE THE ILLINOIS POLLUTION
CONTROL BOARD**

Crownline Boats, Inc., which manufactures fiberglass boats at its facility at 11884 Country Club Road, West Frankfort, Illinois 62896, has filed a petition with the Illinois Pollution Control Board for an adjusted standard on December 5, 2003 (Board Docket Number AS04-1) seeking an adjusted standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code § 215.301 (Use of Organic Material, otherwise known as the 8 lb/hr Rule).

Crownline proposes the following adjusted standard applicable to its fiberglass boat manufacturing operation. "Pursuant to the authority under Section 28.1 of the Environmental Protection Act, the Board hereby adopts the following adjusted standard. This adjusted standard shall apply solely to Crownline Boats, Inc. ("Crownline"). As an alternative to compliance with 35 IAC § 215.301, this adjusted standard allows Crownline to limit its discharge of organic material into the atmosphere from its boat manufacturing operations by complying with the National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants for New and Existing Boat Manufacturing Facilities, set forth at 40 CFR §63 Subpart VVVV, as may be amended in the future."

Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois, 60601.
