

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.P. Novak):

On January 9, 2004, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which AJ Oil Company may appeal a December 3, 2003 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.402, 105.406. Because the postmark date of the joint request is within the time for filing, the joint request was timely filed. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2), 105.404. The Agency approved petitioner's high priority corrective action plan, with modifications, for AJ Oil Company's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at 5723 West Plank Road, Bellevue, Peoria County. The Board extends the appeal period until April 6, 2004, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If AJ Oil Company fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
