All the source notes should be corrected (You have Amended at 27 III. Reg. 16447, effective October 10, 2003 or other previous dates)

130(a)(1) - Since you struck subsection (a) reference to (b)(4) should be corrected, as should the references in (a)(3), (b)(3), (c), (d), (d)(1),(5), (f)(2),(4),(6),(7).

310 final board note, 1st line – put a space between 141.12 and (1994)

611(b) – last 2 lines – "instructions are followed", not "is followed".

640 "Old MCL" 3rd line - strike the period (since you added one in line 2)

640 "Phase I VOCs", 3rd line - strike the period

646(r) - "This subsection (r)"

648(n) - "This subsection (n)"

742(a)(6) - This is the text on file with SOS: "6) Any supplier having either a TTHM annual average = 0.064 mg/l or an HAA5 annual average = 0.048 mg/l during the period identified in subsections (a)(1) and (a)(2) of this Section must comply with subsection (b) of this Section." Why strike a "greater than or equal to" that isn't there?

882(c)(1) reads better as "By no later than April 1, 2000, and by April 1 annually thereafter, or"

Appendix G, endnote 13, 6th line – Add a space between "a" and "Subpart"

Appendix H, endnote 8, last line - Why bold "Agency"?
