The mailbox rule does not apply so that the questions or testimony must be received in the Board's Clerk's office by the appropriate date. The order of the second hearing will be:

- 1. Agency answers to pre-filed questions and follow ups;
- 2. Testimony by the persons who have prefiled testimony followed by questions of the testifier.
