ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):


On January 20, 1998, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) and the Franklin Community Unit School District (petitioner) filed a request for extension of the 35-day appeal period pursuant to Section 40 of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (1996)), relating to a December 16, 1997, Agency determination.

By order of February 5, 1998, the Board reserved docket PCB 98-101 for any petition which might be filed by petitioner in this matter. The order stated, "[i]n the event that petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before March 16, 1998 (the 90th day after December 16, 1997), the Board will dismiss the docket as unnecessary."

Since no petition has been filed, the Board dismisses this matter and closes the docket.
