HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On June 30, 2004, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. If, however, a stipulation is filed prior to the next status conference, the conference will be cancelled without further order.
