HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 15, 2004, all parties participated in a telephone status conference with the hearing officer. The respondent represented that revised supplemental environmental project was rejected and that its intent is to proceed to settle this matter through a monetary penalty. The complainant made an oral motion for an extension of time to and including October 18, 2004, to answer respondent's affirmative defense number 2 that the was not addressed in the Board order. Complainant's motion is granted.

The parties are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 16, 2004, at 9:15 a.m. The status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for their own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
