

- 1. The alleged violations were not caused or allowed by the respondents or in the alternative the alleged violations were the result of uncontrollable circumstances.

b. That said persons without the ability to speak English fluently are no longer employed by the respondents and the difficulties encountered previously concerning the proper manner in which to dispose of debris should no longer be a problem.

WHEREFORE, respondents respectfully pray that the Administrative Citations be withdrawn or they be found not guilty of violations alleged by virtue of the facts herein stated.
