MOTION TO CORRECT HEARING TRANSCRIPT

NOW COMES Water Remediation Technologies, LLC ("WRT") by and through its attorneys, Jeffrey C. Fort and Letissa Carver Reid of Sonnenschein Nath & Rosenthal, LLP, to request, pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code § 101.604, that the Board amend the transcript of the hearing in this matter that took place on October 21-22, 2004. In support of this Motion, WRT states as follows:

1. On June 2, 2004, WRT requested that the Board hold an additional merit hearing regarding the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's proposed rule change regarding radium water quality standards.
2. The testimony of several witnesses for WRT was filed, and the Board held an additional merit hearing on October 21-22, 2004.
3. Upon reviewing the transcript of the October 21, 2004 hearing, WRT noted the following corrections:

4. Upon reviewing the transcript of the October 22, 2004 hearing, WRT noted the following corrections:


