# **Notice of Appeal**

NOW COMES Harold Hart Service, by and through his attorney, Penni S. Livingston and hereby files Notice of Appeal of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency decision regarding application for payment from the Underground Storage Tank Fund for LUST Incident # 981766 at LPC#119-0105-061 pursuant to Section 40 and Section 57.8 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/40, 57.8 and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732. In Support of its filing of Notice of Appeal, the Petitioner states as follow:

- 1. Application for reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund was applied for on September 14, 1999. Application for payment covers the period of August 26, 1998 to November 17, 1998. The amount requested was \$31,024.20 with a deductible determined at \$15,000.
- Application was deemed complete on July 14, 2004 and was promptly denied on August
   19, 2004.
- 3. On September 28, 2004, the parties filed a joint notice of extension of appeal period which was granted on October 7, 2204 with the deadline for appeal being December 27, 2004.

4. This appeal follows and is timely filed on the deadline date. Petitioner appeals the

Agency's denial of reimbursement from the Underground Storage Tank Fund as denial of

reimbursement was improper. Harold Hart is entitled to reimbursement.

5. While Mr. Hart holds hope to resolve differences with the Agency and provide additional

information, this being the last day for appeal, appeal had to be filed for reservation of rights.

Petitioner does not object to an Agency continuance for time of the filing of the record for this

reason.

6. Petitioner appeals the Agency's denial of reimbursement for costs of activities associated

with early action pursuant to Section 57.6(b) of the Act. Other relevant provisions include Section

57.7(a)(1)(B) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.305(b)(1) and (c) and 732.602.

7. Issues may also exist with respect to the Agency's determination concerning the budget

associated with a corrective action plan submitted for a high priority site pursuant to Section

57.7(c)(1)(B) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.405(b) and 732.503(b) and (f).

WHEREFORE, for all these reasons, appeal is hereby filed.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has completed the review of your application for payment from the Underground Storage Tank Fund for the above-referenced LUST incident pursuant to Section 57.8(a) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (Act), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732, Subpart F. This information is dated July 12, 2004 and was received by the Agency on September 14, 1999. The application for payment covers the period from August 26, 1998 to November 17, 1998. The amount requested is \$31,024.20.

The deductible amount to be assessed on this claim is \$15,000.00, which is being deducted from this payment. In addition to the deductible, there are costs from this claim that are not being paid. Listed in Attachment A are the costs that are not being paid and the reasons these costs are not being paid.

On July 14, 2004, the Agency received your complete application for payment for this claim. As a result of the Agency's review of this application for payment, a voucher cannot be prepared for submission to the Comptroller's office for payment. Subsequent applications for payment that have been/are submitted will be processed based upon the date complete subsequent application for payment requests are received by the Agency. This constitutes the Agency's final action with regard to the above application(s) for payment.

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (Board) pursuant to Section 57.8(i) and Section 40 of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. To be considered for reimbursement, early action activities must be performed within 45 days after initial notification to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency of a release. Adm. Code 732.606(o)).

3. \$100.00, deduction for costs that lack supporting documentation (35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.606(gg)). Since there is no supporting documentation of costs, the Illinois EPA cannot determine that costs were not used for activities in excess of those necessary to meet the minimum requirements of Title XVI of the Act (Section 57.5(a) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.606(o)).

This deduction was made on the amount requested for the OSFM permit, there was no receipt submitted as documentation of the cost.

4. \$1,320.85, adjustment in the handling charges due to the deduction(s) of ineligible costs (Section 57.8(f) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.607).

A deduction of \$23.24 for handling charges were made on the ineligible Field Purchases.

A deduction of \$1,297.61 for handling charges were made on the ineligible Subcontractors costs.
