## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J.P. Novak):

On October 21, 2004, at the parties' request, the Board extended until January 11, 2005, the time period for Illinois State Toll Highway Authority to appeal a September 1, 2004 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2002); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.402, 105.406. The Agency granted petitioner's request for a no-further-remediation determination, with conditions added, for Illinois State Toll Highway Authority's leaking underground petroleum storage tank facility located at Lake Forest Oasis East, Tri-State Tollway Northbound, Lake Forest, Lake County. Because petitioner failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
