

**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On March 3, 2005, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The complainant represented that a draft stipulation and proposal for settlement (stipulation) is being reviewed internally and anticipates that it will be forwarded to the respondent in the near future for its review. The respondent made an oral motion for an extension of time to file its answer. The complainant had no objection. Respondent's motion is granted. Respondent's answer is now due to be filed on or before June 6, 2005.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on May 5, 2005, at 9:15 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. If, however, a stipulation is filed prior to the next status conference, the conference will be cancelled without further order.
