


618.200 Purpose

This Subpart prescribes maximum setback zone prohibitions and the applicable technology control regulations that apply under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 615 and 616 in the interest of securing the public health, safety, and welfare; to preserve the quality and quantity of groundwater resources in order to assure a safe and adequate water supply for present and future generations; and to preserve groundwater resources currently in use and those aquifers having a potential for future use as a public water supply. The provisions of this regulation apply to all properties located wholly or partially within the maximum setback zone boundaries of Marquette Heights as delineated in Section 618.Appendix A of this Part:

- a) That are ~~For~~ new potential primary sources of groundwater contamination pursuant to Section 14.3(d) of the Act; and
- b) That are ~~For~~ existing and new activities regulated under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 615 and 616, except that ~~for~~ agricultural facilities that affirmatively opt out of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 615 and 616 are regulated under 8 Ill. Adm. Code 257 or 77 Ill. Adm. Code 830, located wholly or partially within the maximum setback zone boundaries delineated in Section 618.Appendix A of the Part.


