<u>Facts</u>

For this Administrative Citation to Municipal Trust & Savings Bank Trust #1697, the County of Kankakee ("County") states as follows:

- Complainant, County, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r) (2003). County is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.
- 2. Respondent, Municipal Trust & Savings Bank Trust #1697, is an Illinois trust, which is the titled owner of real property located at 4661 S. 750 E. Road, Kankakee, Illinois.
- 3. On March 30, 2005, County inspector Donna Shehane inspected Respondent's property. A copy of her inspection report is attached as Exhibit 1 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
- 4. Based upon direct observations made by Ms. Shehane during the course of her inspection, the County has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:

- a. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)(2003).
- b. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, in violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)(2003).
- c. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general and/or clean construction or demolition debris, in violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)(2003).
- 5. Ms. Shehane's affidavit, attesting to her material actions and observations, is attached as Exhibit 2 and made a part of this Administrative Citation.
- 6. Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5)(2003), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the three violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00).

Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- 1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- 2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send a check or money order, payable to the County, to:

County of Kankakee Planning Department, Solid Waste Division 189 E. Court Street, Suite 200 Kankakee, Illinois 60901

To ensure that you receive timely and proper credit for your payment, complete a Remittance Form (see Exhibit 3, attached) and include it with your payment.

- 3. You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance, with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
- 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.
- 5. The Petition for Review must be filed with: Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board James R. Thompson Center 100 West Randolph Street Suite 11-500 Chicago, Illinois 60601

A copy of the Petition for Review must be served on the County At the following address:

6. The contents of a Petition for Review and the procedures to be followed are governed by the Board's procedural rules. Copies may be obtained from the Clerk of the Board at the address above, by calling the Board at (312) 814-3620, or from the Board's web site at:

- 7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above and imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(2003), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
- 8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.

- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by CDOE and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
- 11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the County of Kankakee may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event you may also be liable for court costs.

GENERAL REMARKS

I arrived on site at approximately 11:50 am, accompanied by Mr. James Greenstreet. Mr. Greenstreet is in training for certification as an Illinois EPA-delegated inspector for Kankakee County. The weather at the time of this inspection was 73 degrees Fahrenheit with south winds at 23 miles per hour, and scattered clouds.

We were driving near the site when we observed smoke drifting from the area. We drove onto the gravel entrance of the site and exited the vehicle to conduct an inspection.

Photo # 1 was taken to the south and depicts waste/debris burning on site. We walked closer to the burn pile, where photos # 2 through # 4 were taken. These photos reveal the open dumping and burning of the following materials: metal, lumber, carpeting, plastic, paper, roofing shingles, other construction and demolition debris, as well as miscellaneous debris. Adjacent to this pile to the south, photo # 5 was taken. This photo reveals metal on the ground and in the corner, smoldering asphalt roofing shingles.

Photo # 6, taken toward the north, again depicts the large dump and burn pile. Photo # 7 was taken toward the north, and reveals the smoldering shingles mentioned above, as well as partially burned metal waste. Photo # 7, taken toward the northwest, is a different view of the large dump and burn pile.

We proceeded to inspect the remainder of the property. Photo # 9 was taken of an abandoned gas cylinder on the ground at the site. Photo # 10 is the large burn pile, taken toward the west.

Photo # 11 reveals scorched grass on site. Photo # 12 depicts a rubber hose on site which has burned.

Photos # 13 and # 14 were taken toward the west of the large burn pile on site. These photos reveal the dumping and burning of construction and demolition debris, as well as other miscellaneous waste including: lumber, concrete, drywall, and metal. Photo # 15

was taken toward the south of the smaller burn pile containing the smoldering asphalt shingles.

Photos # 16 and # 17 were taken toward the northeast and depict a depression on site bordered by gravel. It was not clear what the purpose of this structure is.

Photo # 18 was taken of a fuel container present on site, near the large open dumped and burned waste pile. Some type of fuel was present in the container.

Photo # 19 was taken of metal debris on the ground at the site. Photos # 21 and # 22 were taken of abandoned equipment in the field, which appeared to be in need of repair.

Photo # 22 was taken to the east of a pole building on site, and abandoned, inoperable vehicles on site. Photos # 23 and # 24 show one of the inoperable vehicles and the broken-down skeleton of another vehicle.

More open dumping of waste was observed near the pole building. Photo # 25 shows waste tires on the ground at the site, as well as various parts of an automobile (seat, car door). Photo # 26, taken toward the south, shows an additional abandoned vehicle, as well as three drums containing waste, and miscellaneous debris on the ground.

Photo # 27 reveals two additional waste tires, as well as automotive batteries on the ground and exposed to the elements.

Photo # 28 was taken of additional waste on the ground, including plastic, paper, waste containers, and another automotive battery. More open dumped debris (metal) is seen in photo # 29.

Photo # 30, taken from behind the pole building, shows another abandoned vehicle, and open dumped vehicle part, as well as a semi-trailer on site.

Photo # 31 was taken of an abandoned boat behind the pole building. Photo # 32, taken toward the west, depicts a pile of waste tires on site, containing approximately 25 tires.

Adjacent to the tires, we observed four industrial drums on site (photos # 33 - 35). Debris, including a lawn chair, metal, pallet, and lumber was on the ground around these drums. The drums did contain an unknown liquid and labels were not observed on any of the drums.

Photo # 36 was taken a metal, concrete and debris on the ground at the site. Photos # 37 and # 38 were taken toward the south of additional waste open dumped on site, including: a telephone pole, metal, plastic, and lumber.

Photo # 39, # 40, # 41, and # 42 are close-up photographs of additional waste open dumped and burned on site. The waste in these photographs includes: some type of insulation, wood, siding, plastic, metal, rubber, and miscellaneous debris.

Photo # 43 was taken of the remains of an automobile and an inoperable automobile on the ground at the site.

Before leaving the site, Mr. Greenstreet telephoned the Otto Township Fire Protection District to put out the smoldering fires. A copy of the fire report for this incident is attached.

The Municipal Trust & Savings Bank Trust # 1697 site was found to be out of compliance at the time of this inspection. **Apparent violations cited:**

NARRATIVE

CALLED TO ADDRESS FOR A BRUSH FIRE. UPON ARRIVAL FOUND WHAT WAS LEFT OF A HOME STRUCTURE THAT WAS INVOLVED IN A FIRE APPROX. 4 YEARS PRIOR ON EASTER SUNDAY BURNING AGAIN. THE FIRE DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN CALLED TO THIS ADDRESS MANY TIMES FOR FIRES. THAT ARE GENERALLY INSIDE THE AREA THAT IS WITH IN THE FOUNDATION OF THE OLD HOME. THE HOME WHICH HAS NO ELECTRICAL OR GAS HOOKUP TO THE HOUSE. SOME HOW THIS AREA KEEPS CATCHING ON FIRE. UPON ARRIVAL THIS TIME THE FIRE WAS PRIMARILY IN THE NORTH EAST PART OF THE FOUNDATION. WHICH HAD A LARGE PILE OF DEBRIS WHICH INCLUDED BUT NOT LIMITED TO CAR ENGINE PARTS. TO NAME A FEW. OIL PANS VALVE COVERS AND TRANSMISSION PARTS. ALSO PLASTIC QUART OIL CONTAINERS. THE PILE ALSO HAD FOUNDATION BLOCKS THROUGH OUT THE PILE WHICH APPEARED TO BE MOVED BY SOME TYPE OF LOADER. THEN TO THE NORTH OF THE PILE THAT WAS BURNING THERE WAS A TRACTOR WITH A FRONT BUCKET AND A BACKHOE ON IT. NEXT TO THAT WAS A PLASTIC 5 GALLON GAS CAN THAT WAS APPROX. 




