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### MOTION FOR EXPEDITED HEARING SCHEDULE

NOW COMES, the Chemical Industry Council of Illinois ("CICI"), by its attorneys Mayer, Brown, Rowe & Maw, LLP, and moves the Hearing Officer to schedule both hearings in this matter in the month of July.

In support thereof, CICI states:

- 1. Expediting this rulemaking is desirable to CICI members because it will provide speedy clarification of existing state permitting requirements.
