PROPOSED DISCOVERY SCHEDULE

Pursuant to the Hearing Officer Order of July 26, 2005, the parties submit the following Proposed Discovery Schedule:

- 1. Initial Document Requests and Initial Interrogatories shall be served within 60 days of entry of the Hearing Officer's Discovery Scheduling Order. Initial Document Requests and Initial Interrogatories shall be limited to 25 each, including subparts.
- 2. Responses to Initial Document Requests and Initial Interrogatories shall be served within 90 days of entry of the Hearing Officer's Discovery Scheduling Order.
- 3. Depositions shall be completed within 180 days of entry of the Hearing Officer's Discovery Scheduling Order.
- 4. Final Document Requests and Final Interrogatories shall be served within 210 days of entry of the Hearing Officer's Discovery Scheduling Order. Final Document Requests and Final Interrogatories shall be limited to 15, including subparts.
- 5. Responses to Final Documents Request and Final Interrogatories shall be served within 240 days of entry of the Hearing Officer's Discovery Scheduling Order.
- 6. In the event there is a discovery dispute, the Hearing Officer may adjust the schedule appropriately.
