
**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On October 20, 2005, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The parties appeared optimistic that a settlement will be reached, with the respondent awaiting a no further remediation letter from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. A stipulation and proposal for settlement (stipulation) is being circulated for review.

It was agreed that respondent has until November 4, 2005, to file motion for leave to file its answer and answer *instanter*. The complainant will have 14 days to respond.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on January 19, 2006, at 9:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing. If, however, a stipulation is filed prior to the next status conference, the conference will be cancelled without further notice.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




