Background

On December 22, 2005, the Board received a rulemaking proposal submitted by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) pursuant to Section 27 and 28 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act. 415 ILCS 5/27 and 28 (2004). The Agency proposes amendments to Parts 218 and 219 of the volatile organic material rules to allow for the use of add-on controls as a compliance option for printing operations using cold cleaning solvent degreasing. The Board accepted the proposal for hearing on January 19, 2006.

On February 16, 2006, a status conference was held, and the matter was set for hearing. Hearings will be held on April 19, 2006 and May 17, 2006.

Hearing
