The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its

Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution

Control Board, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

1. On November 22, 2005, , the Illinois EPA received a request from The Andersons

Agriservices, Inc.-Champaign (log number TC-13-06, Exhibit A) for an Illinois

EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control

facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- 3. The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located at SE ¹/₄ of Section 29, T20N, R8E of the 3rd P.M. in Champaign County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Agrichemical containment structures consisting of seven dry fertilizer operational containment structures and the portion of the building over three dry fertilizer operational containment structures as approved under the Agency endorsed Agrichemical Facility Permit No. 01116848 (Log Nos. 01116848 and 05098346).

These facilities collect, transport, and store agrichemical rinsates, residues or

washwaters prior to reuse or disposal, and are further described in Exhibit A.

THIS FILING SUBMITTED ON RECYCLED PAPER

4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2004), defines

"pollution control facilities" as:

"any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property."

- Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5.
- 6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the

requested tax certification.


