#### Facts

For this Administrative Citation to Mr. Bult's, Inc. ("Bult's"), the City of Chicago Department of Environment ("CDOE") states as follows:

- Complainant, CDOE, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois
  Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations
  pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r)
  (2004). CDOE is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill.
  Adm. Code 108.200.
- Respondent Bult's is an Illinois corporation doing business in Cook County,
   Illinois. Bult's operates a waste hauling company that transfers waste from Liberty Waste
   Transfer Station located at 2040 E. 106<sup>th</sup> Street, Chicago, Illinois. The registered agent for Bult's is Ms. Pearl Bult.
  - 3. On May 23, 2006 at approximately 6:00 p.m., while monitoring the exit of Liberty

Waste Transfer Station, CDOE environmental inspector Fred Roseman witnessed a truck leaving the facility and witnessed litter being blown from the truck's trailer. The truck's trailer was not tarped.

- 4. Mr. Roseman observed that MBI and #437 were marked on the door of the truck, and the truck trailer was marked #830 and had license plate #228144ST. A copy of Mr. Roseman's report and his affidavit are attached and made part of this Administrative Citation.
  - 5. MBI is an acronym for Mr. Bult's, Inc.
- 6. Based upon direct observations made by Mr. Roseman during the course of his inspections, CDOE has determined that Respondent violated the Act. Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2005).
- 7. Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2004), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for the violation identified above, for a total civil penalty of **One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars** (\$1,500).

### Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send a check or money order, payable to the City of Chicago, to:

- You may contest this Administrative Citation by filing a Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Appearance, with the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board").
- 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.

- 7. If you do not contest this Administrative Citation by filing a petition for review with the Board within the allotted time, the Board will enter an order finding that you committed the violations alleged above and imposing the statutory civil penalty set forth above. See Section 31.1(d) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) (2005), and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.500(a).
- If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by CDOE and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.

- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
- 11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the City of Chicago Department of Law may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event you may also be liable for court costs.

#### SUMMARY

Site: Transfer station monitored due to previous violations, including loaded transfer vehicles leaving the facility without tarped trailers. This was a permit violation and had caused or threatened litter to exit the trailers while in transit on the public way.

Current conditions: At the facility entrance/exit, I watched outbound vehicle traffic. At approx. 5:55 PM, MBI truck #231 (no trailer #, trailer license #159493ST) exited the facility and it was visibly not tarped. Trailer contents (vinyl siding) were visibly hanging from the trailer top. The vehicle passed my location and began to proceed southbound on Stony Island Av but immediately pulled onto the shoulder when I began to follow. The driver exited the vehicle and asked "What's the problem?". I informed him that I was documenting the untarped condition of his trailer. He claimed that he was unable to tarp the trailer due to his load being too low to stand on. I suggested that he try, and the load was tarped by 6 PM. A five-foot section of vinyl siding fell to the public way during tarping.

At approx. 6 PM, MBI truck #437 (trailer #830, trailer license #228144ST) exited the facility and it was visibly not tarped. The vehicle passed my location (30 ft away, in direct sight of the facility entrance/exit) and proceeded southbound on Stony Island Av. I began driving behind this vehicle and litter was observed becoming windborne and exiting the trailer. The driver pulled onto the shoulder, exited the vehicle and asked why I was pulling him over. I informed him that I did not have jurisdiction over vehicle traffic on the public way but that I was documenting the untarped condition of his trailer. He claimed that he was unable to tarp the trailer due to his load being too low to stand on. I suggested that he try, and the load was tarped by 6:05 PM.

I returned to the facility entrance/exit. At approx. 6:10 PM, MBI truck #492 (trailer #631, trailer license #199969ST) exited the facility and it was visibly not tarped. The vehicle passed my location and proceeded southbound on Stony Island Av. I began driving behind this vehicle. From this position, fine particulates were observed becoming windborne and exiting the top of the trailer. Making a left turn at 122nd St, the entire driver's side of the vehicle was visible: trailer contents were visibly hanging from the top of the trailer. At no time did the driver attempt to rectify the situation as did the two previous drivers.

I contacted MBI Dispatch and left a voice message regarding these incidents.






Photo # 3 Direction SW Comments: VINII SIDING WANGING FROM ONTHEPED TRAILER, LICENSETE 159 493 ST




