
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On June 29, 2006, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Dynegy Midwest Generation, Inc. (Dynegy Midwest Generation) may appeal a May 30, 2006 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). The Agency issued an air permit, with modifications, for construction of a baghouse and sorbent injection system for the Units 1 and 2 boilers at Dynegy Midwest Generation's power station at Oakwood, Vermilion County.

The Board extends the appeal period until October 3, 2006, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Dynegy Midwest Generation fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
