HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On July 27, 2006, the Board received a proposal to amend Parts 810 and 811 of the Board's regulations, which concern non-hazardous solid waste management facilities. See 35 Ill. Adm. Code 810, 811. These filings were submitted by the Illinois Chapter of the National Solid Wastes Management Association (NSWMA), a not-for-profit trade association representing companies that provide various waste-related services. In an order dated August 17, 2006, the Board accepted this matter for hearing. Also in that order, the Board identified two specific deficiencies in the rulemaking petition and directed NSWMA to address those deficiencies in writing prior to any scheduled hearing as directed by the hearing officer.

Both hearings in this matter will be conducted to allow the proponent and then any other interested participants the opportunity to present testimony on the merits and economic impact of the rulemaking proposal. At hearing, all persons who testify will be sworn in and subject to questioning. The Board will also receive any testimony on any economic impact study (EcIS) conducted by the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) on the proposed rules or on DCEO's decision not to perform an EcIS.

The hearing scheduled to take place on Monday, January 29, 2007, may be continued until Tuesday, January 30, 2007, at 9:00 AM if necessary to complete scheduled testimony. Similarly, the second hearing scheduled to take place on Wednesday, February 28, 2007, may be continued until Thursday, March 1, 2007, at 9:00 AM if necessary to complete scheduled testimony.

The Service List for this rulemaking is the list of persons who wish to participate actively in this proceeding and receive not only the Board's opinions and orders but also other filings such as prefiled testimony and public comments. The Notice List is the list of person who wish to receive only the Board's opinions and orders and the hearing officer orders. Note that interested persons may now request electronic notice of filings by providing their e-mail address through the Clerk's Office On-Line (COOL) under this docket number R 07-8. This electronic notice includes notice of the filing of documents that are not typically provided to persons on the notice list. All testimony and any related exhibits for the first hearing must be submitted no later than Monday, January 15, 2007. In addition, NSWMA is directed to address in writing by Monday, January 15, 2007 the deficiencies in its rulemaking petition identified by the Board in its August 17, 2006, order. The "mailbox rule" at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2) does not apply and the Clerk must receive these documents on Monday, January 15, 2007. However, prefiled testimony and other documents may be filed electronically though COOL from the Board's Web site at www.ipcb.state.il.us.
