I found that of the nineteen members who approved the letter, fifteen are affiliated with the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Illinois Natural History Survey (a division of DNR) or with Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. In fact a DNR employee, Mr. Ronald Sauer, drafted the letter!

While I appreciate the position of the IS/AFS as an influential sport minded organization within Illinois, I think the board should question the position taken by this "independent" organization. The IS/AFS chose not to participate in any of the many hearings in this petition. There was no opportunity to cross-examine their opinions nor did they file or present any testimony when they clearly had many opportunities to do so. It particularly distresses me that the letter was submitted without clearly identifying that a great majority of the members responsible for it are employees of the two state agencies who have so strongly opposed the IAWA position. I'd like this letter to be an observation that the position taken by the executive committee and others may not be that of the membership and that the individuals who have chosen to take this position obviously have a conflict in the matter.

I understand that the time for the filing of testimony is expired but I respectfully ask that this letter be accepted and included with the post hearing comments filed by IAWA.
