The toxic waste dump operated by Peoria Disposal Company at Pottstown on Peoria's west boundary sits over our aquifer, according to testimony before the Peoria County Board's recent hearings. We must rely on you, members of the Pollution Control Board, to assure that our water supply receives no additional exposure to hazardous poisons. Winds from the dump should not carry toxic air pollution over us. I believe the best way you can protect us is to uphold the decision by our ~~County Board~~ and deny any expansion of Peoria Disposal's site.
