

HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On February 15, 2007, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. The complainant represented that it has yet to receive certain discovery that prompted its motion to compel filed January 31, 2007. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. IT IS SO ORDERED.




