I am opposed to any overturning of the Peoria County Board's decision to deny any expansion of the Peoria Disposal Company (or other continued or increased use or expansion of the Peoria County waste landfill for hazardous toxic waste of any type -- even after it has been treated or altered.

I consider the transport, treatment and storage of such waste, however treated or protected, to be a safety hazard and/or danger to our community in the present due to aerosols and long term in the likely leaching into the water supply of aquifers and adjacent water resources.

Money to assure -- to the extent possible -- to correct the current risks and prevent future problems should be generated from governmental sources but waste company funds to do so that allows MORE such pollution is not the answer. Thankyou
