ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On June 4, 2007, the Board received a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Willingham Farms may appeal a May 2, 2007 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). According to the joint notice, Willingham Farms received the Agency determination on May 5, 2007. The joint request was therefore timely filed. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b)(2), 105.406. The Agency's determination concerns Willingham Farms' leaking underground storage tank site located at 5713 Shawnee College Road in Pulaski County. In the determination, the Agency rejected Willingham Farms' Corrective Action Plan and Budget.

The Board extends the appeal period until September 7, 2007, as the parties request, based on the May 5, 2007 decision receipt date. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2004); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Willingham Farms fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
