PETITIONER'S MOTION TO VOLUNTARILY WITHDRAW ITS PETITION FOR HEARING TO REVIEW NPDES PERMIT REISSUANCE

NOW COMES Petitioner, CITGO Petroleum Corporation ("CITGO"), by and through its attorneys, Jeffrey C. Fort, Elizabeth A. Leifel, and Sonnenschein Nath & Rosenthal LLP, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Admin. Code 101.500, states as follows:

- 1. On August 14, 2006, CITGO filed a petition for a hearing (the "Petition") to review certain provisions of NPDES permit No. IL0001589, reissued to CITGO's Lemont Refinery on July 28, 2006.
- 2. On June 22, 2007, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("IEPA") issued a Final Modified NPDES Permit (the "Permit") to the Lemont Refinery.
- 3. The Permit reflects the agreements between CITGO and the IEPA resolving the issues raised in the Petition.
- 4. Based on these facts and circumstances, CITGO has determined that it is appropriate to withdraw the Petition.

WHEREFORE, for all of the foregoing reasons, CITGO respectfully requests that the Board grant its Motion to Withdraw its Petition for Hearing to Review Reissued NPDES Permit and to enter an Order dismissing the Petition with prejudice.
