Rochelle Waste Disposal is requesting that they need not comply with the SPECIAL CONDITIONS that were recommended by, *Patrick Engineering Inc.* to maintain the land fill that is located at Creston, Illinois. (Conditions 8, 13, 22, 23, 26, 28, 33 and 34)

The past history of operations of said land fill indicate that all these conditions should be enforced to protect the *HEATH*, *SAFETY AND WELFARE* of the Citizens of Ogle County.

- #8. In the past, litter has accumulated along the areas adjacent to the right of way of Mulford Road and along Route 38.
- #13. Unit 1 has been leaking for some time. It is only reasonable that it be closed as soon as possible. The dump already stinks it's contents should be moved in cooler months.
- #22. Leacate should be drained as quickly as possible without harming the liner.
- #23. The history of the operation indicates that measurers need to be taken to control the litter, block the view and reduce noise from this operation.
- #26. It is important to prevent gas migration away from the landfill.
- #28. Special conditions should be included in applying for the IEPA permit for expansion.
- #33. The maximum height and lateral expansion should be controlled. The sitting application included these guide lines
- #34. This facility should not be used to import waste from afar. Guidelines on the amount of waste collected are necessary to protect the HEALTH, SAFETY and WELFARE of the CITIZENS OF OGLE COUNTY.
