

BRIEF OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

Now comes the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") by its attorney, and hereby files its post-hearing brief in the above-captioned matter. On May 22, 2007, the Illinois EPA filed its Response to Petition for Adjusted Standard. In that Response, the Illinois EPA set forth several reasons for recommending that the Illinois Pollution Control Board approve the adjusted standard being sought by Johns Manville. On July 19, 2007, a hearing in the matter was conducted in Waukegan, Illinois. No members of the public were present at the hearing. The Illinois EPA did not present any testimony at the hearing but did pose questions to Mr. William Bow, witness for Johns Manville, concerning whether the waste in the on-site landfill was inert or not. The Illinois EPA was satisfied with the response given by Mr. Bow as well as that contained in Brief of Petitioner Johns Manville in Support of Adjusted Standard Petition, dated August 30, 2007.

CONCLUSION

The Illinois EPA has no reason to change its recommendation and, therefore, respectfully requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board grant the adjusted standard requested by Johns Manville.


