
I urge the Board to find that the proposed North Milam landfill site in Madison is incompatible with the surrounding area, including Cahokia Mounds World Heritage Site and Horseshoe Lake State Park.

Putting garbage on this sacred site is disrespectful to Native Americans and should be unacceptable to everyone.

In addition, landfills do not belong in wetlands and in the floodplain and should not be sited adjacent to a state park where people fish, hunt, camp, walk trails, observe nature and picnic.

If the North Milam landfill is allowed to fill up and close, it will eventually be a green hill, and this entire area will improve .
