JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004).

FACTS

- 1. That Salam H. Nijme and Shaban Karam A. Nijme are the present owners ("Respondents") of a facility located at the comer of Route 157 and Route 13 in Cahokia, St. Clair County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Cahokia/Nijme.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1630300025.
 - 3. That Respondents have owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on August 22, 2007, Chris Cahnovsky and Joe Zappa of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Collinsville Regional Office inspected the above-described

facility. A copy of their inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Chris Cahnovsky and Joe Zappa during the course of their August 22, 2007 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2004).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2004).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2004).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2004), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty

specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>November 15, 2007</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2004), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2004). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

NARRATIVE

On August 22, 2007, Joe Zappa and I conducted an open dump inspection at the corner of Rt. 157 and Rt. 13 in Cahokia, Illinois. According to St. Clair County records, this site is owned by Salem H. Nijme and Shaban Karam A Nijme. The Nijme's address of record is 312 Largo Drive in Belleville, Illinois 62221-4376.

Site History

This site was originally inspected by the Illinois EPA on April 27, 2006. During that inspection the Illinois EPA observed East Gate Hauling dumping a load of Clean Construction or Demolition Debris (CCDD) on top of other CCDD fill. East Gate Hauling had an employee on-site keeping records of all trucks dumping at this site. A small amount of the material was waste General C&D. In the back of the site the Illinois EPA observed a large amount of household waste dumped at the end a small gravel road. The owner's brother, Steve Nijme, told the Illinois EPA that this waste was fly-dumped on this property. A Violation Notice was sent to the property owner Salem Nijme and East Gate Hauling for the trash and small amount of General C&D. On June 14, 2006, the Illinois EPA met with the USACOE at the site. The Corp told Mr. Nijme that this site was a wetland and posted work stoppage signs at the site. On June 30, 2006, the USACOE issued a Cease and Desist and Order to Restore for this property.

On August 15, 2006, I met with Mr. Nijme's contractor, M&N Construction, at the site. The household waste had been removed to the landfill. M&N was in the process of removing the CCDD out of the wetland and grading the site level. The CCDD was moved to the front of the property which was not a wetland. Landfill receipts were received on September 1, 2006.

On April 6, 2007, I conducted a follow-up inspection. I observed CCDD at this site. It appears that most of the CCDD has been removed from the wetland.

On June 29, 2007, I conduct another follow-up inspection at this site. I observed that new open dumping has been occurring at this site. I observed the open dumping of household waste, CCDD and General C&D. On July 3, 2007, I wrote a letter to the USACOE to inquire the status of any Federal enforcement action. To date, I have not received a reply to my request.

1630300025 – St. Clair County Cahokia/Nijme

Narrative

Joe Zappa and I arrived on-site around 9:30 am. The temperature was about 90° F with dry soil conditions. I observed that even more dumping has occurred at this site since my previous June 29, 2007 inspection.

On the property line between the Walker property and the Nijme property I observed several new piles of waste. This waste consisted of clean construction or demolition debris above grade, general construction or demolition debris, floor tiles, dry wallboard, concrete with protruding rebar, construction site trash and burned trash that had been dumped from off-site. The majority of this waste was on the Nijme site. We then walked down the road to the levee. I observed two piles of trash along the road. One pile was at the beginning of the road. The other was at the end of the road. The waste at the end of the road consisted of a mattress, wood waste and an old TV. This waste has been burned on-site. There was evidence of open burning.

During this inspection I observed the apparent violations of 9(a), 9(c), 21(a), 21(d)(1)(2), 21(p)(1)(3)(7) and 812.101(a).






