<u>JURISDICTION</u>

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004).

FACTS

- 1. That Gene and Elena Greenwood are the present owners ("Respondents") of a facility at the following location: PT SE 820' ON W & 500' on SIDE LYING E RT 37 TRIANGLE EX 1.65 AC IN NE COR., in Goreville, Williamson County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Goreville/Gen Cycle Services.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1998605006.
 - 3. That Respondents have owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on September 5, 2007, Sheila Williams of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Sheila Williams during the course of her September 5, 2007 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2004).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2004).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2004).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2004), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>November 30, 2007</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2004), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2004), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2004). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.


GENERAL REMARKS

On September 5, 2007 a follow-up inspection of the Goreville/Gen Cycle Services site was conducted by Rob Mileur & myself. The initial inspection was conducted on February 28, 2007 at which time apparent violations included open dumping & open burning. On March 30, 2007 an extension was granted until August 13, 2007. It was contingent upon receipt of monthly reports which were to include what actions had been taken & copies of receipts. Some receipts were provided. Through a July 10, 2007 letter from Mr. Greenwood & a phone conversation with Mrs. Greenwood on July 31, 2007, I was informed they have been slowed down with progress due to rain & equipment failure. As a result, another extension was granted until September 1, 2007. During the September 9, 2007 inspection no one else was present at the site.

It was evident that some waste had been removed from the site. This was especially obvious in Area C & Area E. However, new violations were observed. Other than scattered refuse, ten areas of apparent violations were present during the current inspection. These have been designated as Area A – Area J. Scattered refuse included, but was not limited to a burn barrel containing charred & partially melted fluorescent light bulbs, a variety of metal, a hose & dimensional lumber. Area A was a previously noted burn pile containing metal, dimensional lumber & other charred debris. Area A was estimated to be approximately six cubic yards (15'x5'x2') in size. It was difficult to fully observe Area B due to tall & thick vegetation. Area B contained drums, two tires &

a tractor. Area B was estimated to be approximately 44 cubic yards (20'x15'x4') in size. Some of the visible waste in Area C were plastics, metal & demolition debris. Area C was estimated to be approximately 11 cubic yards (15'x10'x2') in size. Area D consisted of two semi-trailers. Vegetation had started growing around the trailers. The doors were open on both of them & contained waste. Area D was estimated to be approximately sixty-nine cubic yards (12.5'x12.5'x12') in size. It was apparent some of the waste in Area E had been removed. Remaining waste included, but was not limited to, a dilapidated cardboard box, a damaged satellite dish, broken pallets, metal, demolition debris, electrical equipment & two tires. Area E was estimated to be approximately 14 cubic yards (30'x12.5'x1') in size. Area F was a pile of metal, demolition debris & general refuse. Not all of Area F could be observed due to vegetation. Area F was estimated be approximately 14 cubic yards (15'x10'x2.5') in size. Area G was a new area exhibiting apparent violations. It was apparent open burning had occurred in Area G due to the typical indicators such as a pyramid shaped piles, a dense amount of ash & blackened refuse in the central portion of the pile & the charred ground decreasing as the outer perimeter of the pile was approached. Waste in Area G included metal, dimensional lumber, general refuse & mail addressed to Mr. Gene Greenwood, mail addressed to Gen Cycle Services, Inc., mail addressed to Elena E. Greenwood & a sales advertisement with the date of September 3, 2007. Area G was estimated to be approximately five cubic yards (12.5'x7.5'x1.5') in size. It appeared some of the debris had been removed from Area H. However, amongst remaining debris, were demolition debris, metal & dimensional lumber. Area H was estimated to be approximately 15 cubic yards (20'x10'x2') in size. Both Area I & Area J were new areas. It was apparent open burning had occurred in these areas due to the presence of charred material & ash in the central portion of the piles. Also, some of the vegetation was blackened around the perimeter of Area I. Among the waste in Area I were dimensional lumber & charred wood. Area I was estimated to be approximately two cubic yards (12.5'X12.5'x.25') in size. Area J contained what appeared to be

bones, dimensional lumber, charred wood, textiles, nails & other pieces of metal. Area J was estimated to be approximately three cubic yards (60'x5'x.25') in size. It should be noted that the estimated amount of waste at this site for this inspection is likely to be lower than the true amount. Due to the presence of thick vegetation in some areas, it was not possible to observe all of the waste. Also, it was apparent repairs had been started on a couple of the buildings.




Goreville | Gen Cycle Services #1998605006 - Williamson County Not to Scale Locations are Approximate




