# JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (2006), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

# **FACTS**

- The Respondent, Frank Smith, is the present owner and in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
- The Respondent, Danny Smith, upon information and belief, is in control and possession and an occupant of a facility located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois.
- 3. The facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code # 0770505065.
  The facility is known to the Agency as the Murphysboro/Frank Smith site.
- The Respondents have owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 5. On January 9, 2008, Don Terry, Field Inspector, Jackson County Health Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Mr. Terry's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

# VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Don Terry's, direct observation, he has determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on January 9, 2008, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

- The Respondents have caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)
- The Respondents have caused or allowed the deposition of general construction or demolition; or clean construction or demolition debris in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7).

## CIVIL PENALTY

In accordance with 415 ILCS 5/42 (b)(4-5), the Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of \$1,500,00 for each of violations specified above. Additionally, should the Respondents select to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described below, after an adjudicatory hearing, the Respondents shall be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the Pollution Control Board. The hearing cost would be in addition to the \$3,000.00 fine.

If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty shall be due and payable no later than March 15, 2007. If you do not petition the Pollution Control Board for review of the Administrative Citation within 35 days of service of the Administrative Citation, or contest the Citation, any judgment that may be rendered against you shall specify the due date of the civil fine and any additional costs assessed against you.

When payment is made, your check should be made payable to the Jackson County's Treasurer Office and mailed to the attention of Shirley Dillinger Booker, Jackson County Treasurer, Murphysboro, Illinois, 62966. Also, please complete and return the enclosed remittance form, along with your payment, to assure proper credit.

If any civil penalty is not paid within the prescribed time, the law allows for the accumulation and payment of interest on the remaining unpaid balance. If any civil penalty is not paid when due, the Office of the State's Attorney shall be requested to initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect the penalty. In addition to the civil penalty, hearing costs, and interest, if any, the Jackson County State's Attorney may seek to recover their costs of litigation.

## PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation, pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/31.1 If you elect to contest this Citation, you must file a Petition For Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition For Review shall be filed with Daniel Brenner, Assistant State's Attorney, Jackson County Courthouse, Third Floor, Murphysboro, Il 62966. YOUR PETITION FOR REVIEW MUST BE FILED WITHIN 35 DAYS OF THE DATE OF SERVICE OF THE PRESENT CITATION ON YOU. IF YOU FAIL TO FILE YOUR PETITION, A DEFAULT ORDER AGAINST YOU WILL BE ENTERED BY THE POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD.

# GENERAL REMARKS

Background: This office first conducted an inspection of this site on September 19, 2003. At that time the open dumping and open burning of waste was observed. The individual who was at the site at that time conducting the burning (who was neither the owner or the resident) said that the material had been removed from the mobile home at the site and he was burning it to get rid of it. When it was determined that Mr. Frank Smith was the property owner, violation notice L-2005–JC129 was sent to him regarding the open dumping and open burning violations. Another violation notice, L-2005–JC130 was sent to the resident, the owner's son, Mr. Danny Smith. During an inspection conducted on November 15, 2004, this inspector spoke with Mr. Danny Smith and explained to him what he needed to do to avoid civil penalties. During this conversation, Mr. Smith confirmed that his father owned the property, that he was living at the site and he was responsible for having the waste burned which I observed during my 09/19/2003 inspection. As of January 28, 2008, the records at the Jackson County Assessor's Office show the site is owned by Frank Smith of West Memphis, Arkansas. The U. S. Post Office in Murphysboro, IL shows that Dan Smith has not submitted a change of address request to them.

During the stated date and time, I conducted an inspection of the site listed above. This inspection was made as a follow up to an inspection conducted on January 3, 2007 during which open dumping violations were observed. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were: cloudy with calm winds and a temperature of approximately 43°F. I was accompanied on this inspection by Bart Hagston of the Jackson County Health Department.

I arrived at the site and called out in a loud voice to announce my presence. No one responded so I began my inspection. I went to an area southeast of the residence where I had observed open dumping during previous inspections. I observed open dumped waste in the same general location as observed during previous inspections (Photos #1 - #3, Site Sketch). The waste included, but was not limited to: plastic bags, plastic containers, metal cans, scrap metal, glass items and household garbage.

To the north I observed another area of open dumped waste (Photos #4 - #6, Site Sketch). The waste in this area included, but was not limited to: plastic containers, vehicle parts, dimensional lumber, aerosol cans, a vehicle engine and cardboard (Photos #4 - #6, Site Sketch).

Nearby I observed two abandoned vehicles (Photos #7 - #10, Site Sketch). I observed no current Illinois licence plates on either vehicle. Also, I observed that the yellow vehicle was missing its back window and the tires of both vehicles had vegetation growing up around them which would indicate that these vehicles had not been moved during this growing season. At the time of the inspection, these vehicles were not in use, were not useable in their current condition, and were not stored in such a way as to protect any future use (Photos #7 - #10, Site Sketch). Behind the blue-green vehicle I observed a pile of waste tires that had been open dumped (Photo #8, Site Sketch).

The total volume of waste at this site was approximately 20 cubic yards.

My inspection ended at approximately 10:50 a.m.

# Violations Observed:




