I ask you to carefully review the new permit to ensure that it does not give PDC a backdoor for expanding operations and does not push the anticipated closure date further into the future. I also ask you to send the permit back and ask IEPA to require more, not less, monitoring of groundwater and air emissions and mandate that monitoring results be analyzed by an independent lab rather than PDC.

When the PDC hazardous waste landfill was grandfathered into existence, I do not believe the state legislature ever intended it to be operational in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
