This notice is spublished pursuant to 415. ILCS: 528.1 and 35. III. Adm. Code 104.88 to inform the public of the submittal by Peorla Disposal Company ("PDC"). 4349 W. Southport Rd., Peorla, III. apis 41615, of a. RCRA delisting adjusted standard pelition, to the III. 1015. Pollution Control Board (the "Board") on April 25, 2008, vacketed as Case No. A 508-10. In the petition, PDC seeks the delisting of residues from the treatment of electric arc furnace! ("EAF") dust created by steel mills, which residues are generated at "PDC's waste stabilization facility located at "439" W. Southport Rd., Peorla, Illinois 61615. The electric arc furnace dust is a listed hazardous waste code (Ko1), idehtified in 35 III. Adm. Code 721.132, The residue that PDC generated from "the streatment of Ko61 EAF dust is classified as a Ko61 EAF dust in the Ko61 EAF dust is classified as a Ko61 EAF dust in the Ko61 EAF the delisting of residues from ous waste by virtue of the "derived-from" rule in 35 III. Adm. Code 721.103(e), because it is generated from the treatment of a listed hazardous waste,

Under the proposed adjusted standard, up to 95,000 cubic yards per year of residue generated at the PDC waste stabilization facility from treatment of K061 EAF dust ("EAF, dust stabilized residues") will be excluded from the list of hazardous wastes contained in Subpart D of 35 III. Adm. Code 721, The EAF dust stabilized residues must meet rigorous verification and batch testing that hazardous constituents are not president in the EAF dust stabilized residues at levels that pose a risk to human health pose a risk to human health or the environment. The EAF dust stabilized resi-dues will no longer be subject to regulation under 35 III. Adm. Code Parts 722-728 and the permitting standards of 35 III.-Adm. Code 703. The EAF dust stabilized residues shall be disposed in a lined landfill with leachate collec-tion and all necessary au-thorizations pursuant to the Board's non-hazardous landfill regulations found at 35 ill. Adm. Code, 810-815. The landfill used for disposal shall be located in the State of Illinois.

Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described delisting proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this no-tice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the dockets number for the delisting proceeding; as found in his profice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Confrol Board, 100 W.
