NOW COMES, THE CITY OF JOLIET (hereinafter, "Joliet"), by and through its attorneys, Drinker Biddle & Reath LLP, and petitions the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") to approve Joliet's motion to withdraw its request for a permit appeal in this matter. In support, Joliet state's as follows:

- 1. On March 21, 2007, Joliet filed a petition with the Board to appeal the permit issued to Joliet by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") on October 2006.
- 2. The October 5, 2006 permit issued by the Illinois EPA Division of Water Pollution Control is identified as 2006-SC-4784 and specifically, allows Joliet to apply sewage sludge from its wastewater treatment plant ("WWTP") operations to agricultural lands.
- 3. Joliet needs to request a modification to its permit and has discussed this with the Illinois EPA.
- 4. Joliet has also discussed the withdrawl of this permit appeal with counsel for the Illinois EPA.

- 5. Mr. Sanjay Sofat, counsel for the Illinois EPA, has agreed that it will not file an objection or reply to this motion.
- 6. Consequently, Joliet requests to voluntarily withdraw its permit appeal in this matter without prejudice.
