## **HEARING REPORT**

On January 13, 2009, a hearing in this matter was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Board Room of the Village of Bolingbrook, at 375 W. Briarcliff Road, Village of Bolingbrook, Illinois. Hearing Officer Brad Halloran was unable to be present due to a death in the family, so the hearing was conducted by the Board's Senior Attorney, Kathleen M. Crowley.

Attorney Roy Harsch, of Drinker Biddle and Reath, LLP, appeared and participated on behalf of the petitioner, City of Joliet. Senior Assistant Attorney General Gerald T. Karr appeared and participated on behalf of respondent Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

#### **Witness Credibility**

Four witnesses testified at the hearing on behalf of the petitioner, City of Joliet. No witness testified on behalf of respondent.

Based upon my legal judgment, experience and observations at the hearing, I find that the credibility of the witnesses is not an issue in this matter.
