On April 20, 2009, Apollo Plastics Corporation (Apollo) filed a motion (Motion) to voluntarily dismiss its appeal of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's October 24, 2008, decision to deny renewal of the construction permit for installation of a Regenerative Thermal Oxidation system for control of volatile organic material.
